
Dear General Brock Parent Advisory Committee:

Discussion

- 1. How do we engage/reach more people to broaden the volunteer pool?
 - Incentives to participants like hot lunch?
 - Send out form at beginning of the school year (or now)?
 - Be clear on how much time/ how much responsibility is required for an opportunity?
 - Especially daytime or evening
 - Provide info early on/well in advance (potentially June for following year)
 - Possibly assign events to classes/divisions for the year?
- 2. Gala specific discussion:
 - Grade 7's received a donation from the PAC for the graduation last year without doing anything for it. Possibly something they can do? E.g. make the "gala" a grade 7 event?
 - We are separating out the Silent Auction from the Gala this year to make it more accessible and spread out the effort over more time.
 - Plates instead of bowls for the class creations so it's easier to paint on.
 - 1. No cap on the possible price for class creations
 - Incorporate a 50/50?
 - Balloons with prizes inside (done in the past)?
 - With no chair/committee set up, potentially a simpler event this year for the Gala
 - Make the Gala more accessible to the broader Brock community e.g. lower price point, etc.

Discussion

- 3. Is it possible for more online safety discussion/education for students?
 - Sarah suggested a Telus program that she would share the information with Principal Sterling.
 - Principal Sterling said she would investigate opportunities for this.
- 4. As part of the SEL presentation there was some discussion about trends on the Brock playground addressed by Principal Sterling and School Counsellor Sihota:
 - Addressing things that develop during unstructured time/ on the playground
 - Soccer students needed to pause for two days recently, bringing in red/yellow cards and refs, events develop very quickly on the soccer pitch
 - Peer helpers on the school grounds make a difference wear yellow vests to easily identify on the playground; these leaders support younger students in using their "WITS". Also "LEADS" (see photos next slide)
- 5. Mr. Cruz (Div 12 teacher) attended the meeting and spoke at the end to comment on the Brock parents generosity and support for the school making the community at Brock a great one to be a part of.

No motions required in this meeting.
